Introduction

The **Revillagigedo Archipelago**, better known as “Socorro Islands”, is a group of four volcanic islands located about 250 nautical miles south of Cabo San Lucas, in Baja California, a southwestern state of Mexico.

These islands are **only accessible via liveaboard**. The complete isolation of this archipelago in the middle of the Pacific has favored the concentration of **great marine life** that has made it one of the must-see diving destinations on the entire planet, only comparable to the Galapagos or Cocos Island, due to its encounters with pelagic fish.

You can see **giant mantas** in many places around the world. But nowhere else boasts a population of giant mantas that literally seek out interaction with divers. While mantas are the main reason to voyage out to Socorro, there are lots of other animals to see, including **schooling hammerheads** and silky sharks, plus 12 other species of sharks, occasionally **bottlenose dolphins** that hang out with divers at certain dive sites.

ITINERARY

Day 1

5pm boarding Rocio del Mar at port San José del Cabo.

Check in, security and boat briefing, dinner and sailing to Revillagigedo.

*It takes approximately 26-28 hours one-way to reach the islands.

Day 2



Time to relax before our underwater adventure begins. Bring a book to read!

During this day we will sail south.

San Benedicto will be our first stop.

Day 3-8

Diving, diving and more diving!

Exploring famous divesites like Cañón, Boiler, Cabo Pierce and Roca Partida.

Creating memories that will last a lifetime!



Day 9



Sailing back to San José del Cabo.

Time to dry your scuba gear and check out the fantastic photos and videos of the trip.

Day 10

Breakfast in the morning. Check out at 8am.

Liveaboard “ROCIO DEL MAR”

Day 1 (December 27th, Monday)

5pm check in at port San José del Cabo. Once on board, there will be a security and boat briefing, crew introduction and cabin assignment, before we navigate to San Benedicto overnight (It takes approximately 26-28 hours one-way to reach the islands).

Day 2-9 (December 29th till January 3rd)

The 2nd day we will be still navigating towards the remote Revillagigedo Archipelago. Once there, we will have a routine of between 3 or 4 daily dives, we will dive at the islands of San Benedicto, Socorro and Roca Partida. All our dives will be done from pangas (mexican word for dinghy). We will finish the trip with another long navigation heading back to San José del Cabo.

Day 10 (January 5th, Wednesday)

Breakfast, 8am check out and transfer to Los Cabos Int'l Airport (SJD) or to your hotel of choice.

DIVING

We will dive for 6 days non-stop - mythical places like El Cañón, El Boiler, Cabo Pierce and Roca Partida.

If the weather conditions allow, there will be 4 daily dives, except for the day we have to register at the Isla Socorro Naval Base.

The use of Nitrox is highly recommended! Let's keep in mind that these are dives with an average depth of between 20 and 30 meters. If you need assistance during panga entry or exit inform our crew. They are happy to help!

After the last dive of the trip we will clean our equipment and begin our navigation back to San José del Cabo.

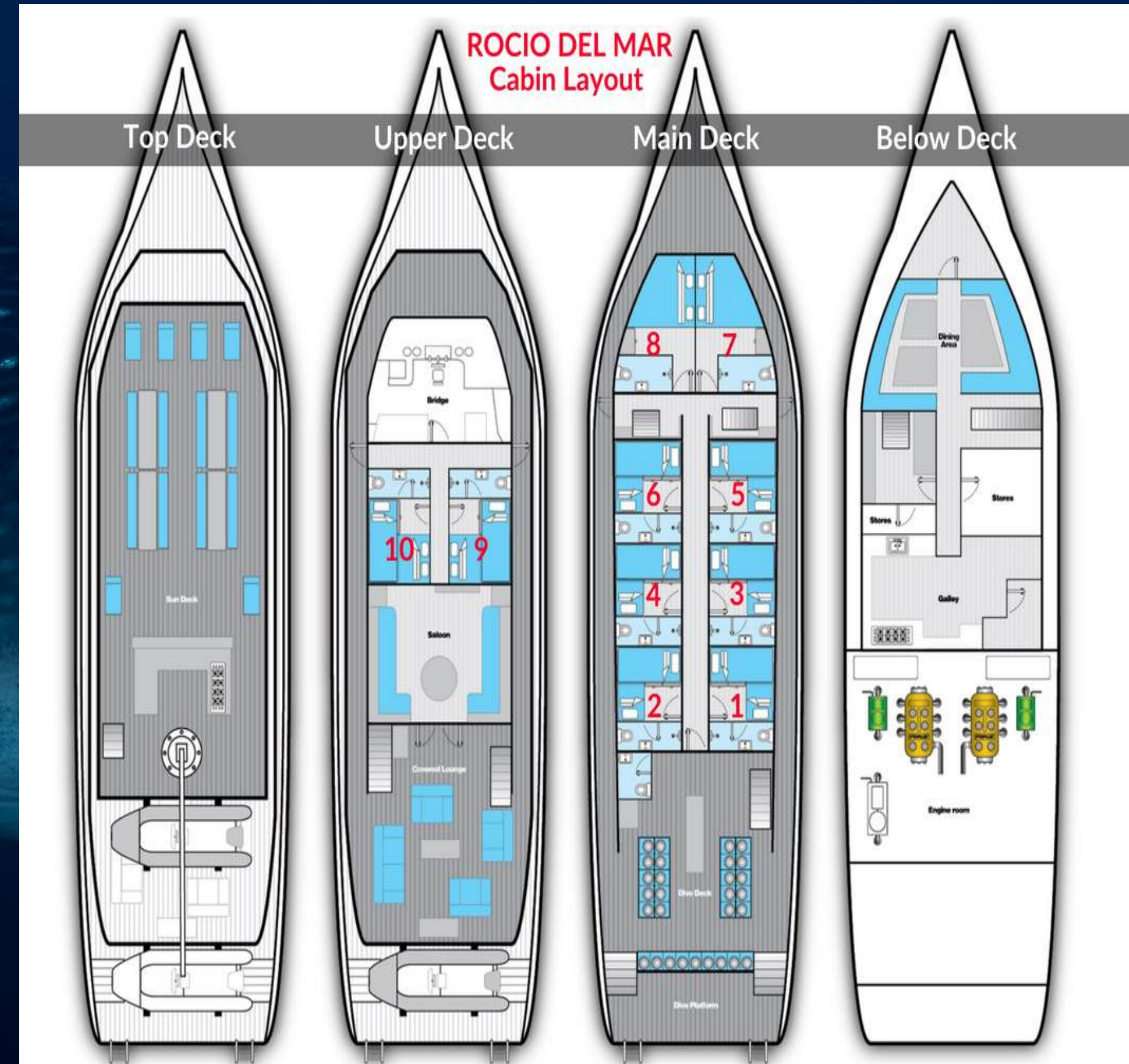

- Comfortable salon with sofas, TV, computer table set up, books and DVD's.
- Well organized dive deck with gear storage for all your diving equipment.
- Spacious camera table with lots of power outlets.
- Dive platform for easy access to the inflatable pangas.
- 2 Rinse showers on the dive platform.
- 2 on-board compressors.
- Large shaded sundeck with lawn chairs - perfect for relaxing between dives.
- 2 inflatable pangas with drivers to get you to and from the dive sites - each has a sturdy ladder for the safety and comfort of our divers.
- All power is 110 (just like the US).
- Wet gear storage is available on the diving deck, so there is no need to lug gear or clutter your stateroom with it.
- Smoking is allowed only on the top sun deck.

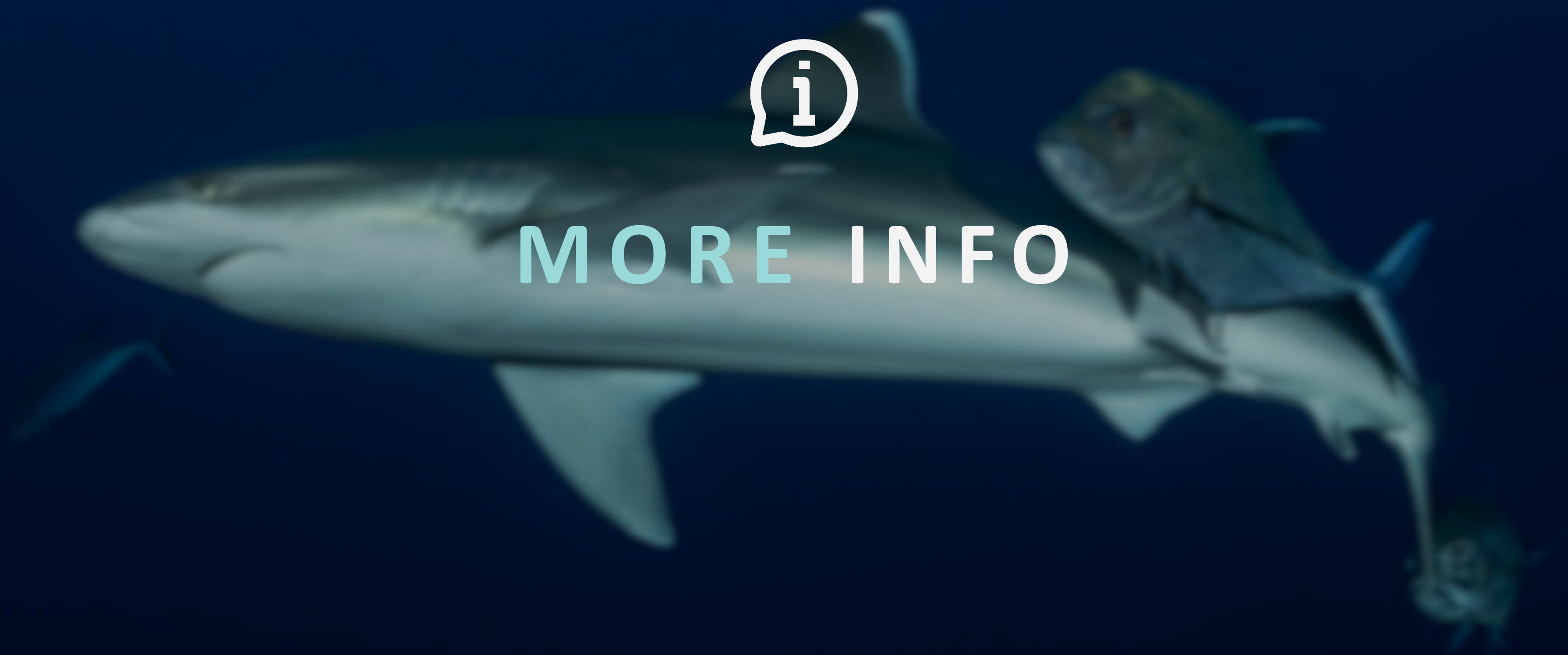

We will contact you if there are changes to required immigration documentation.

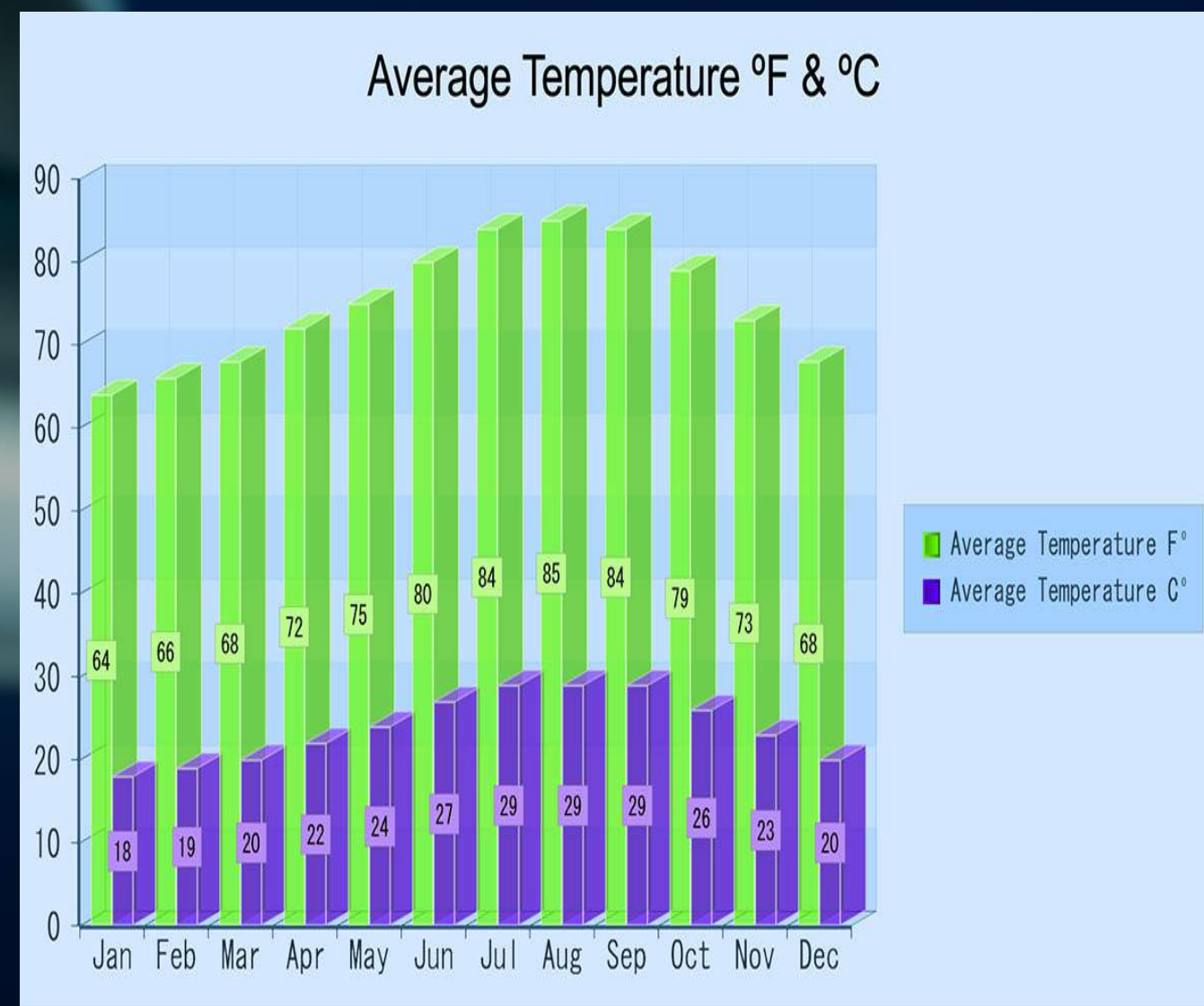
Airport

Arriving and Departing - Los Cabos Int'l Airport (SJD)

Major airlines such as American Airlines, United, Spirit Airlines, Alaska Airlines, Delta, Frontier Airlines, Southwest, Sunwing, Air Canada, West Jet, Swoop, Flair Airlines, Volaris, Viva Aerobus and Aeroméxico fly weekly to Los Cabos and, once landed, a variety of transportation options are accessible, including shuttle services, car rentals, or taxis to make traveling to and from your hotel easy.

Climate



We recommend 5 to 7 mm wetsuits because the average water temperatures in November is: 23 C (75 F)

Electricity

In Mexico the power plugs are of type A and B. The standard voltage is 127 V and the frequency is 60 Hz. In Mexico the plugs are like the ones in USA.

We recommend that you always travel with an adapter in case you make a stopover in a country with other types of plugs.
